- Aqueous barley straw extract as a source of plant derived Lignin, which acts to inhibit the growth and reproduction cycles of algae.

Treatment

- This product will not deteriorate rapidly when stored in the shade out of direct sunlight (U.V.), however, it should be used as soon as practicable following delivery.
- The treatment should be carried out through the algae season (early March through to late October).
- It is therefore recommended that the critical application of Lake Aid BioX is during the spring or early summer to prove most effective in the control of algae.
